
To ensure reliable and safe operation of this equipment, please read carefully all the instructions in this user guide, especially the safety information below.


#### **Electrical safety**

- The TV set should only be connected to a mains supply which matches that stated on the label.
- To prevent overload, don't share the same mains supply socket with too many other items of equipment.
- Do not place any connecting wires where: they may be stepped on or tripped over.
- Do not place heavy items on them, which may damage the leads.
- Hold the main plug, not the wires, when removing from a socket.
- During a thunderstorm or while leaving the TV for long periods, set the switch off.
- Do not allow water or moisture to enter the TV or mains adaptor. Do NOT use in wet or moist areas, such as Bathrooms, steamy kitchens or near swimming pools.
- Pull the plug out immediately, and seek professional help if: the mains plug or cable is damaged, liquid is spilt onto the set, or if it is accidentally exposed to water or moisture, anything accidentally penetrates the ventilation slots, the set doesn't work normally.
- Do not remove the safety covers. There are no user serviceable parts inside. You may invalidate the warranty. This apparatus must only be serviced by qualified personnel.
- To avoid battery leakage, remove exhausted batteries from the remote control, or when not using far a long period.
- Do not break open or throw exhausted batteries on a fire.


#### **Physical safety**


- Do not block ventilation slots in the hack cover. You may place the TV in a cabinet, but ensure at least 5cm (2") clearance all around.
- Do not tap or shake the TV screen, or you may damage the internal circuits. Take good care of the remote control.
- To clean the TV use a soft dry cloth. Do not use solvents or petrol based fluids.
- Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers stoves or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong, the wide blade or the third prong is provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs.
- Use only attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.
- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Servicing is required when the apparatus has been damaged in any way, such as power-supply cord or plug is damaged, liquid has been spilled or objects have fallen into the apparatus, has been exposed to rain or moisture, does not operate normally or has been dropped.




### Wall Mounting

- Installation of the LCD TV in an improperly ventilated location can cause a fire or damage to the LCD TV due to increased temperature.


















### Installing an Antenna

For connecting to ATSC or NTSC broadcasts



Press TV/AV button on the remote control to select TV, then press OK button to confirm. Then you can receive the ATSC/NTSC signal.

### **Remote Control**

#### Functions of remote control buttons

The remote control is using Infra-Red (IR). Point it towards the front of the LCD TV. The remote control may not work correctly if it is operated out of range or out of angle.

#### **POWER**

Press to turn the TV on/standby

#### **MUTE**

Press to mute the sound.

Press again or press VOL+ to unmute.

#### CH+/-

Channel/Program +/-

#### VOL+/-

Volume +/-

#### **PICTURE**

Press repeatedly to cycle through the available video picture modes.

#### SOUND


Press to cycle through the different sound settings.

#### **ASPECT**

Press to cycle through the different screen display mode.

#### **FREEZE**

Press to catch the current picture.

Press to display the input source menu

#### CC

Press to display the closed caption.

#### MTS

Press to select the audio channels.

#### **FAV**

Press to display teh favorite channels list.

#### **EPG**

Press to enter the EPG menu directly.

#### **DISPLAY**

Press to enter the EPG menu directly.

#### **NUMBER BUTTONS**

To select the program directly. e.g.:

Select channel 5, press "5" button. Select channel 62 press "6" button, and press "2" button in 2 seconds. Select channel 152 press "1" button, and press "5" button, then press "2" button

in 2 seconds. select channel "5-1", press "5" then "-/--" and "1".

### Remote Control

### THUMBSTICK ( $\blacktriangle$ / $\blacktriangledown$ / $\blacktriangleleft$ / $\blacktriangleright$ /OK)

Allows you to navigate the on-screen menus and adjust the system settings to your preference.

#### MENU

Press to display the OSD menu.

#### **RETURN**

Press to Return to the previous channel viewed.



#### **EXIT**

Press to exit form the OSD menu.

#### **TIMER**

Press to setup the sleep time among: 5min, 10min, 15min, 30min, 45min, 60min, 90min, 120min, 180min, 240min and off.


### **Precautions**

### **Avoiding Remote Control Problems**

- 1. Check the polarity (+,-) of the batteries in the remote control.
- 2. Check that the batteries have power.
- 3. Check that the LCD TV is powered and that it is properly plugged in.
- 4. Check if any three-wavelength lamp, special fluorescent or neon sign is turned on near the LCD TV.

### Inserting Batteries in the Remote Control

- 1. Open the cover completely.
- 2. Insert the two supplied batteries (AA, 1.5V). Ensure that the polarities (+ and -) of the batteries are aligned correctly.
- 3. Silde back the cover.



CAUTION : Risk of explosion if battery is replaced by an incorrect type.



### How to use remote control


- The remote control should be operated within 30 feet (7m) and 30 ° to the left and the right of the IR receiver at the front of the LCD TV.



### Trouble shooting

- Do not use other functions that are not mentioned in this user's manual.
- In case a problem occurs with your LCD TV, please take the following steps first.
- If you still have the problem, turn the power off and contact your dealer or an authorized service center.

Problem	Action
The screen does not appear.	Is the power plug pulled out? Insert the power plug.  Press the power button of the remote control.
The screen appears too slowly after the power is turned on.	This problem occurs for a brief time in the process of image elimination processing in order to hide temporary screen noise that occurs when the power is turned on. But if the screen does not come after 1 minute contact your dealer or an authorized service center.
Screen is too bright or too dark.	Perform brightness adjustment or Contrast adjustment.
Screen is too large or too small.	Adjust the screen size.
Stripes appear on the screen and it shakes.	Stop using wireless telephones, hair driers and electric drills.
Screen appears, Voice is not heard	1. Press the "MUTE"button. 2. Increase the sound level by pressing volume adjustment button. 3. Check if sound terminal of external input is connected properly. 4. Check if audio cables are connected properly. 5. Select and check the other input.
