



WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK OR INJURY:

- Do not leave appliance when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning or servicing.
- · Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center. Call 1-800-263-6376 for the nearest service center.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: To reduce the risk of electric shock, this appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician to install the proper outlet. Do not change the plug in any way.

THERMAL PROTECTOR: An internal thermal protector has been designed into your cleaner to protect it from overheating.

When the thermal protector activates, the cleaner will stop running. If this happens, proceed as follows:

- 1. Turn the cleaner OFF and disconnect it from the electrical outlet.
- 2. Check dirt cup and filters for dirt accumulation.
- 3. Refer to "If You Have A Problem" section.
- When cleaner is unplugged and the motor cools for 30 minutes, the thermal protector automatically resets and cleaning may continue.

If the thermal protector continues to activate after following the above steps, your cleaner may need servicing (see "Service" section).

1. Features

Cleaner description

Operate cleaner only at voltage specified on data plate on bottom of cleaner.


The assembled cleaner will look like the drawing.








2. How to Assemble Handle Assembly



Slide handle through top of back panel until it snaps into place.


Tool Storage



Attach tools: (a) Slide the dust brush into the hole on the back of the cleaner with bristles facing out. Slide the Crevice Tool (b) onto round post on the back of the cleaner and snap into place. Clip Power Brush Tool onto the front of the cleaner (c).


3. How To Use

Cord Release



Turn Quick Cord Release for easy cord removal.


Height Adjust Lever



Turn the height adjustment knob to match the surface being cleaned.

IMPORTANT: For easiest adjustment, place cleaner in full upright position.

On/Off Switch



Plug cord into electrical outlet. Turn cleaner on by pressing the on/off switch located on the side of unit.

Handle Release Pedal




To release handle, push the handle release pedal located on the lower left side of the cleaner.

CAUTION: Brushroll continues to rotate while hose is removed or in use and at all times while cleaner is on. Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from brushroll area while cleaner is on.


Cleaner must be in the upright position to lift the rotating brushroll off the carpet when cleaning above the floor.

Floor/Carpet Cleaning




Move the handle and adjust it to the desired position for (a) storing the upright, (b) operating the cleaner, and (c) depress the handle release pedal again to clean under furniture. NOTE: Rotating brushroll could cause area rug fringe to become tangled within cleaner. Use caution when vacuuming throw rugs with fringe.


Above Floor Cleaning



Cleaner must be in its upright position to raise brushroll.




Press handle/extension wand release button and pull handle/extension wand up to remove.



Pull hose end out of lower hose and remove the hose from the tool caddy.

Extension Wand



Lift wand cap to attach hose to handle/extension wand. Choose any of the handy accessories or use the extension wand alone.



Simply push the attachment firmly onto the end of the extension wand. To remove tool, twist and pull apart gently.



Carry Handle

Cleaner must be in its upright position to raise brushroll.



Dirt Cup & Filter: Removal & Replacement



Empty Dirt Cup




Press dirt cup release button and remove dirt cup from cleaner.




Hold dirt cup inside garbage can and press clean release dirt cup button to empty. Tap the dirt cup on the inside of garbage can to remove excess dust.

Remove Cyclone Dust Cup




Twist and remove cyclone dust cup.




Tap the cyclone dust cup on the inside of a garbage can to remove excess dust and dirt from cup.

Replace Cyclone Dust Cup



Replace cyclone dust cup and twist to secure.

Remove Foam Filter




Press tab on bottom of foam filter cover and pull to remove.

Clean Foam Filter




Tap the foam filter assembly on the inside of a garbage can to remove excess dust and dirt from filter.

Wash Foam Filter




Hold foam filter under running water to wash. Ring excess water out of filter. Allow filter to dry for at least 24 hours before replacing in filter cartridge.

Replace Foam Filter




Return foam filter assembly to cleaner and snap into place. Replace foam filter cover and snap into place to secure.

Remove HEPA Media Filter



Press tab on side of HEPA Media filter cover and lift to remove.




Press tab on HEPA Media filter and lift filter out of base of cleaner.

Clean HEPA Media Filter



Tap the HEPA Media filter on the inside of a garbage can to remove excess dust and dirt from filter.

Replace HEPA Media Filter



Return HEPA Media filter to base of cleaner and snap into place.



Replace HEPA Media filter cover and snap into place to secure.

Replace Dirt Cup



Return dirt cup to cleaner. Align slot on bottom of dirt cup with tab on cleaner. Push to snap into place.

NOTE: Each time the dirt cup is emptied, the foam filter should be cleaned. Tap the filter firmly against the inside of a trash can until the dirt stops falling from the filter. (Filter will be discolored after use, this will not affect the filter's performance.) Do not brush the filter. The cleaning instructions may vary depending on the dirt conditions. In some cases, more or less cleaning of the filter may be required.


Belt Or Brushroll: Removal & Replacement

TOOL REQUIRED: phillips or flathead screwdriver

WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury from moving parts - Unplug cleaner before changing belt or brushroll.

To Remove Belt



Lay cleaner flat and flip cleaner to expose nozzle base. Base should lay flat and face up. To remove nozzle guard, use Phillips screwdriver to remove the three (3) screws. Arrows show location of screws.



Flip cleaner right side up. Rotate nozzle guard forward and lift off.




Lift and remove brushroll. Dispose of old belt.


To Replace Belt Or Brushroll




Slide belt onto motorshaft.




Place new belt in area of brushroll without bristles.



With new belt in place, pull and slide brushroll into nozzle making sure that the brushroll end caps are in the correct orientation (A). Rotate brushroll manually to make sure belt is properly aligned.



Reattach nozzle guard by aligning the four (4) tabs in the base slots (Figure B). Rotate nozzle guard back in place (Figure C).




Replace all three (3) screws to secure nozzle guard.

Lightbulb: Removal & Replacement

TOOL REQUIRED: Flathead screwdriver.

WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK - UNPLUG CLEANER BEFORE REMOVING OR REPLACING LIGHTBULB.

This cleaner uses a common automotive lamp #906, 13.0 volts. For built replacement call 1-800-263-6376 or your local auto parts store.



Using the end of a Flathead screwdriver, gently pop open the lens (Figure A). Remove lens (Figure B).



Pull bulb out of socket. Do NOT twist. Gently push bulb into socket to replace.



Replace lens by aligning tab and snapping into place.

Debris Removal



Debris Removal from Hose


Check to see if dirt cup is full; empty if needed.

Plug cleaner in and check to see if there is any suction at end of hose. If there is suction at end of hose, move on to Figure 2.28. If there is no suction at the end of hose, follow these steps:

- 1. Unwrap hose from caddy. Twist and unlock to remove clogs. Clean out hose with a broom handle. Check access door on back of cleaner (near hose end). Remove the seven (7) screws and check for obstruction (Figure A).
- 2. Remove dirt cup and check dirt cup inlet located on cleaner (Figure B).
- 3. Remove nozzle guard (see Figure C) by removing the three (3) screws. Remove obstructions (Refer to "Belt and Brushroll removal and replacement").




Debris Removal from Power Brush Tool



Turn the Turbo Tool/Power Brush over and slide off the 0-ring.



Pivot lower housing and remove cloq.



To reassemble, be sure tabs are engaged. Pivot the lower housing closed. Slip the O-ring into the groove at the neck of the Turbo Tool/Power Brush to complete reassembly.

5. If you have a problem occurs, it usually can be solved quite easily when the cause is found by using the check list below.
