Care and Cleaning

Screen (Turn TV Off)

- Use a mild soap solution or window cleaner with a soft clean cloth. DO NOT USE ABRASIVE CLEANERS.
- Avoid excessive moisture and wipe dry.

Cabinet and Remote Control

- For plastic cabinets and Remote Control, use a soft cloth dampened with water or a mild detergent solution. Avoid excessive moisture and wipe dry.
- For wooden cabinets, use a soft cloth and an occasional coat of furniture polish to preserve the finish.
- Do not use benzene, thinner or other petroleum based products.

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Installation

Television Location

This unit is intended to be used with an optional stand or entertainment center. Consult your dealer for available options.

- Avoid excessive sunlight or bright lights, including reflections.
- □ Keep away from excessive heat or moisture. Inadequate ventilation may cause internal component failure.
- Fluorescent lighting may reduce Remote Control transmitting range.
- Avoid magnetic equipment, including motors, fans, or external speakers.

Optional Cable Connections

Shielded audio and video cables should be used between components. For best results:

- Use 75-ohm coaxial shielded cables.
- Check type of output and input connectors on your components.
- Determine required cable lengths.

AC Power Supply Cord

CAUTION: TO PREVENT ELECTRIC SHOCK, MATCH WIDE BLADE OF PLUG TO WIDE SLOT OF AC OUTLET AND FULLY INSERT. DO NOT USE A PLUG WITH A RECEPTACLE OR OTHER OUTLET UNLESS THE BLADE CAN BE FULLY INSERTED TO PREVENT BLADE EXPOSURE. FOR SOME MODELS THAT ARE NON-POLARIZED, THE USE OF AN AC ADAPTOR CONNECTOR MAY BE NECESSARY.

Cable / Antenna

For proper reception, either a cable or antenna connection is required.

Cable Connection

Connect the cable supplied by your local cable company.


Note: A cable converter box may be required for proper reception. Check with your local Cable company for compatibility requirements.

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Antenna Connection

- For proper reception of VHF/UHF channels, an external antenna is required. For best reception an outdoor antenna is recommended.
- Antenna Mode must be set to TV in the SET UP menu.



Incoming Cable from Home Antenna








Incoming Cable from Cable Company

INSTALLATION Optional Equipment Connections

VCR's, video disc players, video game consoles, and DSS equipment can also be connected to the video inputs. See the optional equipment manual for details.



Procedure

- 1. Connect equipment as shown to rear Audio/Video input jacks.
- 2. Select the Video mode by pressing **TV/VIDEO** button.
- 3. Operate optional equipment as instructed in equipment manual.
 - **Note:** The S-VIDEO connection is optional and overrides other VIDEO connection. Use INPUT 1, AUDIO R and L with S-VIDEO connection.

TO AUDIO AMPlifier

Connect to an external audio amplifier input for listening to a stereo system.

Note: TO AUDIO AMP terminals cannot be connected directly to external speakers.

Audio Adjustments

- 1. Select TV SPEAKERS ON located in the AUDIO menu on screen.
- 2. Set amplifier volume to minimum.
- 3. Adjust TV volume to desired level.
- 4. Adjust amplifier volume to match the TV.
- 5. Select TV SPEAKERS OFF&VAO from AUDIO menu.
- 6. Volume, mute, bass, treble and balance are now controlled from the TV.
 - Note: In OFF&FAO the volume is controlled by the external amplifier.

Picture In Picture (PIP) Operation

With / Without A VCR And Cable Box

This television includes a two tuner Picture In Picture (PIP) feature. This allows watching two (2) live broadcasts at the same time without or with an external video source (VCR).

Without A VCR (External Video Source)

Procedure


- Connect incoming cable to antenna (ANT) input on back of TV.
- Press the PIP button on the Remote Control to display the PIP frame.

Note: The audio is for the Main Picture, only.

- Choose channels for the *PIP* frame by pressing the Remote Control **PIP** CHANNEL up/down buttons.
- Choose channels for the Main Picture by pressing the Remote Control CH up/down buttons or by using the numeric keypad.

With A VCR (External Video Source) And Cable Box

Connect your television to a VCR and Cable Box, as shown.

Note: The Remote Control must be programmed with supplied codes to operate the VCR and Cable Box. See Programming the Remote Control in the **Remote Control Quick Reference Guide**.

Procedure


Note:

Press the **PIP** button on the Remote Control to display the PIP frame.

Note: The audio is from the Main Picture only.

- To view scrambled channels through your Cable Box in the PIP frame:
 - Press the **TV/VIDEO** button on the Remote Control to select the same video input which your cable box is connected to.
 - Verify the CABLE BOX and VCR are ON and the VCR tuned to channel 3.
 - Choose channels for the *PIP* frame by pressing the **CBL** button on the Remote Control and using the numeric keypad or **CH** up/down buttons.
 - Choose channels for the Main Picture by pressing the TV button on the Remote Control and using the numeric keypad or CH up/down buttons.

The **SWAP** button switches the PIP and Main Picture source. Press the **RECALL** button for PIP and Main Picture source status, on screen.





Procedure

Press the PIP button on the Remote Control to display the PIP frame on screen.

Note: The audio is from the Main Picture only.

- To view an external video source in the PIP frame:
 - Press the TV/VIDEO button on the Remote Control to select the same video input which your VCR is connected to.
 - Verify the VCR is on.
 - Choose channels for the Main Picture by pressing the TV button on the Remote Control and using the numeric keypad or CH up/down button.
 - Choose channels for the PIP frame by pressing the TV button on the Remote Control and using the PIP Channel up/down buttons


ACTION Button

Geomagnetic Corr (Correction)



In SET-UP menu, select GEOMAGNETIC CORR to adjust discoloration due to the geomagnetic field in the area. Use the Remote Control navigation keys to adjust the tilt bar parallel to the bottom of the picture frame.



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


Program Timer






Game Guard Lock


In LOCK menu, use to prevent video games and VCR tapes from being viewed for 12, 24, or 48 hours using a secret code.

Unlock GAME GUARD by re-entering the same three-digit secret code.









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Unlocking Game Guard
