

Installation

Television Location

This unit is intended to be used with an optional stand or entertainment centre. Consult your dealer for available options.






- Antenna Mode must be set to TV.








Optional Equipment Connections

VCR Connection

VCRs, video disc players, video game equipment, and DSS equipment can also be connected to the video inputs. See the optional equipment manual for more information.



Procedure

- 1. Connect equipment as shown to front or rear Audio/Video input jacks.
 - Note: Front and rear Audio/Video connectors cannot be operated at the same time.
- 2. Select the Video mode by pressing TV/VIDEO button.
- 3. Operate optional equipment as instructed in equipment manual.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING USE OF VIDEO GAMES, COMPUTERS, DSS OR OTHER FIXED IMAGE DISPLAYS.

The extended use of fixed image program material can cause a permanent "shadow image" on the picture tube. This background image is viewable on normal programs in the form of a stationary fixed image. This type of irreversible picture tube deterioration can be limited by observing the following steps:


- A. Reduce the brightness/contrast setting to a minimum viewing level.



Audio Adjustments

- 1. Select TV SPEAKERS ON from AUDIO menu.
- 2. Set amplifier volume to minimum.
- 3. Adjust TV volume to desired level.
- 4. Adjust amplifier volume to match the TV.
- 5. Select TV SPEAKERS OFF&VAO from AUDIO menu.
- Volume, mute, bass, treble and balance are now controlled from the TV.
 Note: In OFF&FAO the volume is controlled by the external amplifier.





Press the PIP button on the Remote Control to display the PIP frame.

To view a different picture in the PIP frame:

- D Press the TV/VIDEO button on the Remote Control to select the video PIP source.
- □ Verify the CABLE BOX and VCR are ON and the VCR is tuned to channel 3.
- □ Choose channels for the *PIP* frame by pressing the **CBL** button on the Remote Control and using the numeric keypad or **CH** up/down buttons.
- □ Choose channels for the *Main Picture* by pressing the **TV** button on the Remote Control and using the numeric keypad or **CH** up/down buttons.






