- 1. HEADPHONE jack- To connect earphone (not supplied) for personal listening.
- 2. AUDIO L (in) jack- Connect to the left channel audio output jack of a video camera or VCR.
- NOTE: The rear-panel AUDIO L (IN) jack is for mono input. The sound is heard from both speakers. Use this jack for monaural audio equipment to be hooked up.
- AUDIO R (in) jack- Connect to the right channel audio output jack of a video camera or VCR.

CABINET CLEANING

- Wipe the front panel and other exterior surfaces of the TV with a soft cloth immersed in lukewarm water and wrung dry.
