# STAND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR BAND SAW 21460 AND SCROLL SAW 22436

#### UNPACKING




Figure 1 - Unpacking

 Check for completeness, Locate all parts before attempting assembly (see Figure 1).

NOTE: Hardware to mount tools to stand is not included.

**CAUTION:** Do not attempt assembly if parts are missing. Follow assembly instructions. Use parts list to order replacement parts.

- A Long Upper Cross Brace (2 each)
- B Short Upper Cross Brace (2 each)
- C Long Lower Cross Brace (2 each)
- D Short Lower Cross Brace (2 each)
- E Leg (4 each)
- F Top (2 each)

## **ASSEMBLY**

Tools required: Phillips screwdriver, adjustable wrench and portable drill.

## **ASSEMBLE FRAME**

**NOTE:** Finger tighten fasteners until all metal components are assembled. Then tighten all fasteners securely.

**NOTE:** Use pan head screws and lock nuts. (Figure 7, Key Nos. 8 and 9) to assemble all components except the top and leveling pad.




Figure 2 - Assemble Leg Set

- Assemble a long upper cross brace (A) and a long lower cross brace (C) to the two legs (E). The braces are assembled to the INSIDE of the legs (see Figure 2).
- · Repeat for the other two legs and long cross braces.




Figure 3 - Connect Leg Sets

 Connect each leg set by attaching the two short upper cross braces (B) and the two short lower cross braces (D) (see Figure 3).

Tighten all fasteners completely.

## **ASSEMBLE LEVELING FOOTPAD**




Figure 4 - Assemble Leveling Footpad

- Insert pad onto countersink screw (see Figure 4).
- Thread nut onto screw. Insert screw into and through footpad.
- Place washer on screw. Thread second nut onto screw.

## ATTACH FOOTPADS

 Slide one footpad onto the bottom of each leg. (One footpad will include leveling device). Align corner of footpad to corner of leg and press footpad onto leg.

### **ASSEMBLE TOP**




Figure 5 - Top Hole Pattern

 Location of pre-drilled holes used in attaching the top to the frame are indicated in Figure 5.




Figure 6 - Attaching the Top

 Place the boards together and then place the assembled frame on the boards. Attach frame to boards using wood screws and washers through the slots in the frame (see Figure 6).

**NOTE:** The center screw requires one washer under the screw head and one additional washer between the frame and board.

Center Screw Requires Extra Washer Between




Figure 7 - Drill Mounting Holes for Scroll Saw

**IMPORTANT:** For scroll saw 22436, the two rear and one of the front mounting bolts will need to be located through the slots in the frame. Carefully drill the two holes shown in Figure 7 and then place saw on stand, mark location of the other two holes, then drill holes.




Figure 8 - Parts Illustration for Stand
