

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# THIS VACUUM IS INTENDED FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY.

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE.
- ALWAYS FOLLOW THESE SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS.
- DO NOT LEAVE VACUUM CLEANER UNATTENDED.
- WARNING: FULLY ASSEMBLE VACUUM CLEANER BEFORE OPERATING.
- WARNING: THE CORDS, WIRES AND/OR CABLES SUPPLIED WITH THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS CHEMICALS, INCLUDING LEAD OR LEAD COMPOUNDS, KNOWN TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA TO CAUSE CANCER AND BIRTH DEFECTS OR OTHER REPRODUCTIVE HARM. WASH HANDS AFTER USING.

# WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK OR INJURY:

- Do not leave appliance when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before servicing.
- Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center for inspection. Call 1-800-321-1134 for the nearest service center.
- Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair and anything that may reduce air flow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- Look on your vacuum cleaner and follow all label and marking instructions.
- Do not use an extension cord with this cleaner.
- Keep end of hose, wands and other openings away from your face and body. Keep your hands, feet, hair and clothing away from moving parts.

- Do not use the vacuum cleaner without dirt container and/or filter in place.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches or hot ashes.

# WARNING:

To reduce the risk of electric shock, this appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician to install the proper outlet. Do not change the plug in any way.

Your cleaner contains a thermal protective device to shut off the motor to avoid overheating. If this happens, turn switch off and unplug the cleaner. Inspect the exhaust, inlet, and filter for any blockage. Empty the dirt container and clean filter. After approximately 30 minutes the motor will have cooled and the vacuum will be ready to use. **NOTE:** *The cleaner must remain unplugged and in the off position during the 30 minute cooling period.*

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#### LIMITED WARRANTY





# **HOW TO OPERATE**


**CAUTION:** To avoid injury, particularly to face and head, keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from the revolving brush.




### ATTACHMENT USAGE

**NOTE:** Always turn off appliance before connecting or disconnecting attachments. **CAUTION:** To avoid injury, particularly to face and head, keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from the revolving brush.

#### **TO USE ATTACHMENTS AND/OR HOSE**




Connect adaptor plate/hose to metal nozzle guard by latching the two longer tabs on the adaptor plate with the rear of the nozzle guard. Pivot the adaptor plate/ hose upward to latch the two smaller tabs on the adaptor plate with the front of the nozzle guard.



With adaptor plate/hose connected to the metal nozzle guard, select the appropriate tool or combination of tools to attach to the end of the hose. 3.

Use the tools to clean tight corners and hard to reach spaces.



**NOTE:** To remove adaptor plate/hose, push in on the adaptor plate/hose release button while pivoting the adaptor plate down and away from the metal nozzle guard.


# DIRT CUP & FILTER: REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT

WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF INJURY FROM MOVING PARTS - UNPLUG BEFORE REMOVING OR REPLACING FILTER.

NOTE: For best performance, replace filter every 6 months to a year depending on use.



#### **EMPTY DIRT CUP**



Hold unit as shown and press the dirt cup release button to empty contents into wastebasket. **NOTE:** For best results, periodically remove filter and tap against wastebasket to remove remaining dirt.


#### **CLEANING AND REPLACING FILTER**




Remove dirt cup by twisting counterclockwise and pulling away from unit.




Grasp center tab on filter adapter. Pull out of dirt cup to remove filter assembly.




To clean, tap filter assembly against wastebasket to remove remaining dirt and then return filter assembly to dirt cup. If replacing filter, proceed to step 5.



Twist old filter to remove from filter adaptor. **IMPORTANT:** DO NOT DISCARD FILTER ADAPTOR.



Twist and lock new filter into filter adaptor.



Return filter assembly to dirt cup.



Replace dirt cup by aligning tabs and twisting clockwise until it locks into place.

\*FOR BEST PERFORMANCE: Each time the dirt cup is emptied, the filter should be cleaned. Tap the filter firmly against the inside of a trash can until the dirt stops falling from the filter. (Filter will be discolored after use, this will not affect the filter's performance.) Do not brush the filter.

## **BELT OR BRUSHROLL: REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT**


TOOL REQUIRED: PHILLIPS SCREWDRIVER AND BELT LIFTER

WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF INJURY FROM MOVING PARTS - UNPLUG BEFORE CHANGING BELT OR BRUSHROLL.




#### TO REATTACH BELT




With the unit turned off and unplugged, use a phillips screwdriver to remove the belt door screw located above the brushroll window.




Slide the belt door down and angle out to remove from the unit.




Use belt lifter and hold as shown.



Dip the belt lifter inside the belt access area and hook the belt around the lip of the belt lifter. Slip the belt onto the motor shaft until the belt lifter base meets the shaft. To ensure proper belt placement, gently turn belt lifter counterclockwise and remove. Make sure belt is on shaft.




Belt should look like the illustration above. IMPORTANT: THE BELT WILL COME OFF IF NOT PROPERLY INSTALLED.




Attach belt door to unit and secure with screw.


#### **TO REPLACE BROKEN/WORN BELT OR BRUSHROLL**



With the unit turned off and unplugged, use a phillips screwdriver to remove the belt door screw located above the brushroll window.




Slide the belt door down and angle out to remove from the unit.




Use belt lifter and hold as shown.


# **BELT OR BRUSHROLL REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT: CONTINUED**




To remove the belt, hook the belt on the left side of the motor shaft, turn clockwise and pull the belt towards you to release.




Remove screws on bottom of metal nozzle guard as shown.




Remove metal nozzle guard and pull brushroll and belt straight out from unit,




With the new belt properly located in the channel on the middle of the brushroll, slide the brushroll straight down into the unit. **NOTE:** *Make sure the brushroll end caps align with the tabs inside the brushroll housing (see inset).* Brushroll is not symmetrical, its orientation is important.




Attach the metal nozzle guard, ensuring that tab is engaged before securing with the screws.



Dip the belt lifter inside the belt access area and hook the belt around the lip of the belt lifter. Slip the belt onto the motor shaft until the belt lifter base meets the shaft. To ensure proper belt placement, gently turn belt lifter counterclockwise and remove. Make sure belt is on shaft.



Belt should look like the illustration above. IMPORTANT: THE BELT WILL COME OFF IF NOT PROPERLY INSTALLED.



Attach belt door to unit and secure with screw.
