

- NEVER unplug your wine cellar by pulling on the power cord. Always grip the plug firmly and pull it straight out from the outlet.
- Repair or replace immediately all electric service cords that have become frayed or otherwise damaged. Do not use a cord that shows cracks or abrasion damage along its length or at either the plug or connector end.
- When moving your wine cellar away from the wall, be careful not to roll over or damage the power cord.
- DO NOT store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance.
- DO NOT allow children to climb, stand or hang on the wine cellar doors or shelves in the wine cellar. They could damage the wine cellar and seriously injure themselves.

- Keep fingers out of pinch point areas; clearances of the door and cabinet are narrow.
 - Be careful closing doors when children are in the area.
- Unplug your wine cellar before cleaning or making any repairs.
- **NOTE:** We strongly recommend that any servicing be performed by a qualified individual.
- This wine cellar must be properly installed in accordance with the **Installation Instructions** that are in wine cellar.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

A DANGER: RISK OF CHILD ENTRAPMENT

Junked or abandoned wine cellars are dangerous...even if they will sit for just a few days. If you are getting rid of your old wine cellar, please follow the instructions on the right to help prevent accidental child entrapment.

BEFORE YOU THROW AWAY YOUR OLD WINE CELLAR

- Take off the door.
- Dismantle locking device.
- Leave the shelves in place so that children may not easily climb inside.

CFC DISPOSAL

If you are disposing of an old wine cellar it may have a cooling system that used CFCs (chlorofluorocarbons). CFCs are believed to harm stratospheric ozone.

If you are disposing of an old wine cellar, make sure the CFC refrigerant is removed for proper disposal by a qualified servicer. If you intentionally release this CFC refrigerant, you can be subject to fines and imprisonment under provisions of environmental legislation.

GROUNDING REQUIREMENTS


IMPORTANT: Please read carefully.

TO CONNECT ELECTRICITY

A WARNING

Electrical Shock Hazard

FOR PERSONAL SAFETY, this appliance must be properly grounded. Have the wall outlet and the circuit checked by a qualified electrician to make sure the outlet is properly grounded.



RECOMMENDED GROUNDING METHOD

The wine cellar should always be plugged into its own individual properly grounded electrical outlet rated for 115 Volts, 60 Hz, AC only, and fused at 15 or 20 amperes. This provides the best performance and also prevents overloading house wiring circuits which could cause a fire hazard from overheated wires. It is

recommended that a separate circuit serving only this appliance be provided. Use a receptacle which cannot be turned off with a switch or pull chain. Do not use an extension cord.

Where a standard two-prong wall outlet is encountered, it is your personal responsibility and obligation to have it replaced with a properly grounded three-prong wall outlet.

Do not, under any circumstances, cut or remove the third (ground) prong from the power cord.


NOTE: Before performing any type of installation or cleaning, disconnect the wine cellar from the electrical source. When you are finished, reconnect the wine cellar to the electrical source and reset the control panel to the desired setting.

USE OF EXTENSION CORDS

Because of potential safety hazards under certain conditions, we strongly recommend against the use of an extension cord. However, if you still elect to use an extension cord, it is absolutely necessary that it be a UL-listed (USA), 3-wire grounding type appliance extension cord having a grounding type plug and outlet, and that the electrical rating of the cord be 15 amperes (minimum) and 120 volts.

Use of an extension cord will increase the clearance needed for the back of the wine cellar.



WINE CELLAR INSTALLATION

A WARNING

Excessive Weight Hazard

Use at least two people to move and install wine cellar. Failure to do so may result in back or other injury.

UNPACKING YOUR WINE CELLAR

Remove tape and any temporary labels from your wine cellar before using. Do not remove any warning-type labels, the model and serial number label, or the TechSheet that is attached to back wall of the wine cellar.

To remove any remaining tape or glue, rub the area briskly with your thumb. Tape or glue residue can also be easily removed by rubbing a small amount of liquid dish soap over the adhesive with your fingers. Wipe with warm water and dry.

Do not use sharp instruments, rubbing alcohol, flammable fluids or abrasive cleaners to remove tape or glue. These products can damage the surface of your wine cellar.

A WARNING

When Moving Your Wine Cellar:

Your wine cellar is heavy. When moving the wine cellar for cleaning or service, be sure to protect the floor. Always pull the wine cellar straight out when moving it. Do not wiggle or walk the wine cellar when trying to move it, as floor damage could occur.

A WARNING



Explosion Hazard

Keep flammable materials and vapors, such as gasoline, away from wine cellar.

Failure to do so can result in death, explosion or fire.

INSTALLATION

- 1. To avoid vibration, the unit must be level. If required, adjust the leveling legs to compensate for unevenness of the floor. The front should be slightly higher than the rear to aid in door closing. Leveling legs can be turned easily by tipping the cabinet slightly. Turn the leveling legs clockwise () to raise the unit, counterclockwise () to lower it.
- 2. Install this appliance in an area where the temperature is between 55°F (13°C) and 110°F (43°C.) If the temperature around the appliance is too low or high, cooling ability may be adversely affected.
- 3. Allow the clearance of at least 4" from the top and 2" from the side walls for better cooling efficiency, ease of installation, proper air circulation and electrical connections.
- **▲ CAUTION:** Avoid placing the unit near heat sources, direct sunlight or moisture.
- 4. Clean your wine cellar thoroughly and wipe off all dust accumulated during shipping.

NEXT

- 1. Please connect with power supply. Plug into a 115V grounded outlet.
- 2. Your wine cellar is now ready for use.
- 3. Set your temperature to your desired setting. (See page 9)

A WARNING

 Do not put hands, feet or metal sticks into air vents, back cover or bottom of wine cellar. You may be injured or receive an electrical shock.

MOVEMENT AND TRANSPORTATION


MOVING THE WINE CELLAR

Before moving

- 1. Remove all contents from the wine cellar.
- 2. Disconnect the power plug.
- 3. Secure loose parts, such as shelves, with tape.
- 4. Raise the wine cellar a little and tighten the leveling legs in as far as possible.

During transportation

- 1. Hold onto the leveling legs while carrying.
- 2. Always carry the wine cellar in an upright position never tipped to the front, back, or side.
- 3. Wine cellars are heavy. It must be lifted by at least 2 people.



Fasten the door with a removable tape to prevent it from opening.

IF THIS HAPPENS

INSUFFICIENT COOLING

When a large amount of wine is placed into the wine cellar, more time is needed to reach the desired temperature and get stabilized. (Sudden changes in temperature are the main reason for damage to wine flavor)

POWER OUTAGE

Open and close the door as little as possible. After power is restored, the displayed temperature defaults to 57°F. Reset if needed. (see page 9)

INTERIOR LIGHT MALFUNCTIONS

Contact service center.


UNIT IS NOT IN USE

Disconnect power supply and clean wine cellar interior. Open the door for 2-3 days to dry the wine cellar (to prevent mold and bad odor). When the wine cellar is restarted, the displayed temperature defaults to 57°F. Reset if needed.

USING YOUR WINE CELLAR

WINE CELLAR TEMPERATURE CONTROL


- Temperature range is 46°F to 64°F.
- The temperature can be adjusted in 1°F increments.



CHANGE THE TEMPERATURE

Default (factory) setting is 57°F.

① Press "Temp Adjust" button for 3 seconds. When "Temp Adjust" button is pressed, the temperature indicator blinks.



② Each press of the warmer or colder temperature button will raise or lower the temperature by 1°F.



③ After the temperature is selected, the temperature display will stop flashing and lock the temperature setting in 10 seconds.



④ For the best results, select a temperature setting in the range specified for each type of wine.

RED 53°F~64°F **WHITE** 46°F~52°F

⑤ To change the temperature display from °C to °F or °F to °C, press and hold the "Temp Adjust" and "Light" buttons simultaneously for 3 seconds.



STORAGE TEMPERATURE FOR WINE

- Note that the temperature of the upper compartment cannot be set colder than the lower compartment.
- When it is first plugged in, the temperature is set to RED (57°F).
- The recommended temperature range for wine is:

WHITE 46°F~52°F RED 53°F~64°F

- The time for the interior temperature to reach the set temperature varies with the specific usage of the wine cellar.
- The displayed temperature is the set temperature, which may be different from the actual temperature of the wine stored in the wine cellar.
- After a power outage, temperature resetting is needed. Resetting can be made in accordance with instructions above.

WINE SHELVES

1. CENTER SHELF WITH CONTROLS

It is not designed to pull out. Do not pull out.

2. WIRE SHELVES(3)


To Remove and Replace the Wine Shelves

- 1. Pull the wine shelves forward, lifting it up and out of supports.
- 2. Replace the shelf by inserting the shelf into the supports and sliding it toward the rear of the wine cellar.



It is not designed to pull out except for cleaning.

4. WOOD TRIM




Your wine cellar has a natural wood trim on the wine shelves. You may choose to stain the wood trim or to apply a clear finish coat. If you opt to stain or coat the wood trim, remove the shelves from the wine cellar before staining. Allow the shelves to dry for a minimum of 24 hours or in accordance with the manufacturers directions, whichever is longer, before returning them to the wine cellar.


WINE STORAGE GUIDE

LOADING DIRECTION

 Upper Shelves: When loading the shelves, place the wine bottles in opposite directions as shown. Maximum 8 bottles.



 Bottom Shelf: When loading the shelf, place the wine bottles in opposite directions as shown. Maximum 9 bottles.





CARE AND CLEANING


Clean the shelves and the wine cellar interior thoroughly once every year.

1. Before cleaning

Disconnect power plug.

2. Cleaning wine cellar surfaces and door gasket

Clean with soft towels dipped in warm water or detergent. If mild detergent is used, wipe dry with a clean towel.



NORMAL OPERATING CONDITIONS

There are normal noises inside the wine cellar

· Sound of coolant flowing.

There are cooling lines in the rear, which often make a noise under normal operation.

Interior light does not come on when opening the door.

- There is an "on/off" button for interior light.
- The interior light will automatically shut off after one hour if left ON.

Moisture on the door gasket

Moisture drops may appear on the door gasket when outdoor temperature and humidity are high.
 Wipe them away with a dry cloth.

EXTERNAL MOISTURE

External moisture on the surface

 Same as what happens when icy water is filled into a glass, i.e. external moisture will appear on its outer surface.

External moisture may appear when warm and humid air touches the unit, especially in hot weather. Wipe it away with a dry cloth.

Internal moisture

• Internal moisture may appear if the door is opened frequently when it is hot and humid.

It will disappear automatically as product operates. It is recommended to wipe away moisture with a dry cloth.

ODOR

New product odor

Same as a new car or new furniture which will give off an odor.

The odor from the new product may come from plastic components or other items used inside.

The wine cellar does not operate	• Is power supply on?	Check if other electric appliances operate or not.
	Is power plug inserted into socket?	Re-connect the plug properly.
Inefficient cooling	• Is the door closed tightly?	 Raise the wine cellar front slightly using the leveling legs. Move wine bottles away from the door to allow it to close tightly.
	 Is it under direct sunlight or near heat sources such as gas stove? 	Check the installation location.
	 Is the distance between the wine cellar and surrounding items appropriate? 	 See wine cellar installation(page 7) for appropriate clearances.
	 Is the ambient temperature appropriate? 	 Temperatures above 55°F and below 110°F are appropriate.
Loud noise/ Abnormal sound	Is the floor flat and firm and is it installed solidly (noise may be louder on wooden floor)?	Please install wine cellar on flat and firm floor.
	 Is there anything stacked on top or behind the wine cellar? 	Clear away stacked items.
Moisture appears in the interior	• Is the door closed tightly?	Make sure the door is closed and the gasket is sealing properly. The moisture will disappear after the door is closed tightly. It is recommended to wipe excessive moisture away with a dry cloth.
The door can not be closed tightly	Is the wine cellar tilted forward?	Please adjust the leveling legs (adjusting the wine cellar front slightly higher will allow the door to be closed tightly).
	Are shelves placed correctly?	Place shelves properly.
